

## DIGITAL NOMAD VISA

### General Preliminary Requirements:

(i.) To work for a foreign company exclusively with the use of computer, telematic and telecommunication means and systems. It would also be allowed to work for a company located in Spain, provided that the percentage of such work does not exceed 20% of the total of its professional activity.

(ii.) To be a graduate or postgraduate of universities of recognized prestige, vocational training and business schools of recognized prestige or with a minimum of three years of professional experience.

### Procedure

Applications can be made from the country where the applicant legally resides or from Spain if the applicant is within the validity of the period given to stay or reside in Spain.

#### Application from outside of Spain: (not yet applicable from the UK)

Applicants must submit their application at the corresponding Spanish Consulate in their country of origin or in the country where they reside.

Once the documentation has been assessed and if all the requirements are met, a visa will be issued with a maximum duration of one year. The visa may be of a shorter duration if requested by the employee or self-employed worker. The nomad visa will be sufficient to reside and work remotely in Spain during its validity.

#### Application from within Spain:

Applicants who are in Spain with a residence permit or with a temporary permit as a visitor, can submit their applications at the Unidad de Grandes Empresas – UGE. If the permit is granted, it will last 3 years unless a shorten period is requested.

Once the decision is made, the applicant will have 30 days to apply for a Foreign Identity Card at their local Police Station where the applicant's biometric information will be

taken. After this first appointment, the applicant will be asked to collect its card approximately 45 days after applying.

Decisions on this type of application take an average of 20 working days.
